\$10 allows an at-risk elementary or middle school student to receive a 2 hour tutoring session.

\$30 can provide 2 girls with a Girl Scout membership for one year. This provides them with the opportunity to experience leadership development programming that will positively impact their lives.

\$50 fills a car with a tank of gas so a low-income individual can get to and from work and continue to support their family.

\$80 buys weekend meals for one student for an entire 38-week school year which prevents them from going hungry when not in school.

\$104 will fund 2 prostate or mammogram screenings for low income patients helping them with early detection of potential conditions.

\$120 gives 2 teenage boys with autism the thrill of experiencing summer camp for the first time through Camp Cool Kids & Teens, a day time summer camp for children and youth with special needs.

\$160 covers the GED exam test fee for 1 adult GED student and expands their employment opportunities when they pass the test.

\$250 will provide specialized nursing services that allow a medically fragile child to attend preschool at Challenged Child & Friends.

\$300 allows 2 high school students to retake a previously failed course online to receive credit and graduate on time.

\$500 provides 2 scholarships to Lanier Tech students in need to cover costs not covered by the Hope Scholarship resulting in them staying in school to complete their degree.
