

- Helped 263 Forsyth County households who received financial assistance from The Place, giving them the support they needed to get back on their feet.
- Provided a safe, home-like environment for over 104 boys and girls where they received therapeutic services to aid in their education and development.
- Sheltered **197** women and children from their abusers, providing a safe environment, food, case management, legal advocacy and counseling.
- Delivered 1,340 meals to elderly, disabled or homebound clients who otherwise may not qualify or are on the waiting list for the Meals on Wheels program.
- Provided care to 31 individuals that were victims of sexual assault through counseling and support services.
- Gave 152 children and youth with special needs the opportunity to enjoy summer camp through Camp Cool Kids & Teens.
- Reached over *843* youth through one-on-one and group mentoring programs through Mentor Me-North Georgia.
- Provided GED and ESOL instruction to over *832* students through Literacy Forsyth, giving them the tools to obtain a better paying job and allowing them to become more self-sufficient.
